**5. Presentation on Dockless Bike Share Stations (JD Simpson / San Antonio Bcycle)**

**Issue**

Dock-less bike share systems are an emerging practice in many cities, including Austin, San Francisco, and Portland. Instead of a physical kiosk at which to check bikes in and out, dock-less bike share bikes have a GPS tracking system and a U-Lock that serves as the checkout point. Depending on the business model, users can leave bikes anywhere there is space, rather than having to return the bike to a designated bike share station. JD Simpson with San Antonio Bcycle will present on this new use of technology and discuss the benefits and drawbacks.
