ATAC Co-chairs Nomination and Selection Process

- Every two (2) years, the ATAC will elect two (2) Co-Chairs from its current membership.
- The Co-Chairs shall be elected by a majority of the members present at the meeting.
- One Co-Chair will represent the cycling or micromobility community and one co-chair will represent the pedestrian community.
- The Co-Chairs will alternate leading ATAC meetings.

ATAC Co-chairs Nomination and Selection Process (contd.)

- At the February 9, 2022 ATAC meeting,
 - A nomination was made for Robert Hanley to be the co-chair representing the pedestrian community.
 - Nominations were also made for Carl Bradtmiller, Jeff Jordan, or Kari Kuwamura to be the co-chair representing cycling or micromobility community.
- An ATAC member survey held from February 17-25, 2022 collected additional nominations for Jessica Brunson or JD Simpson to be the co-chair representing cycling or micromobility community.

Selection of ATAC Co-Chair Representing the Pedestrian Community
