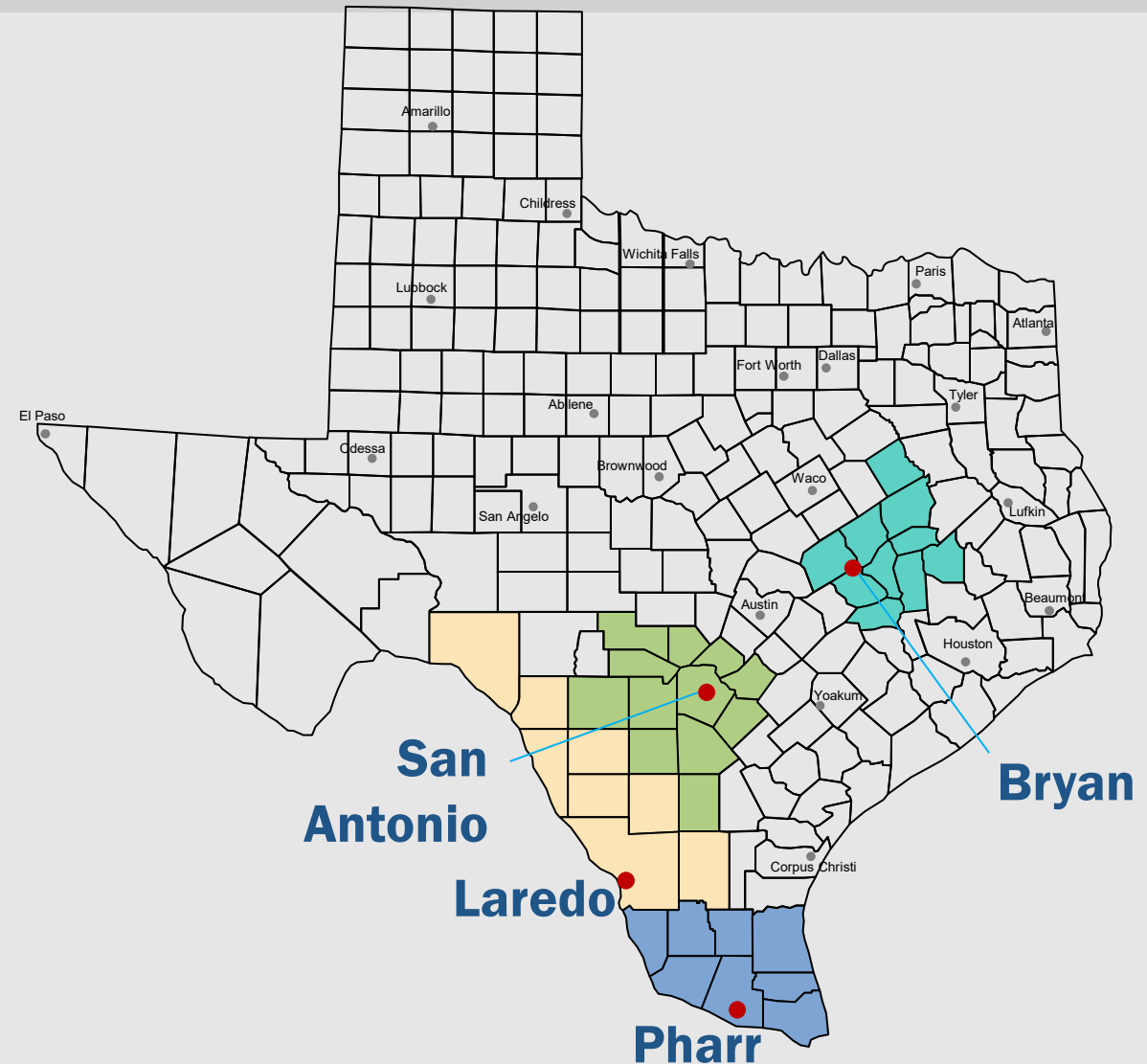

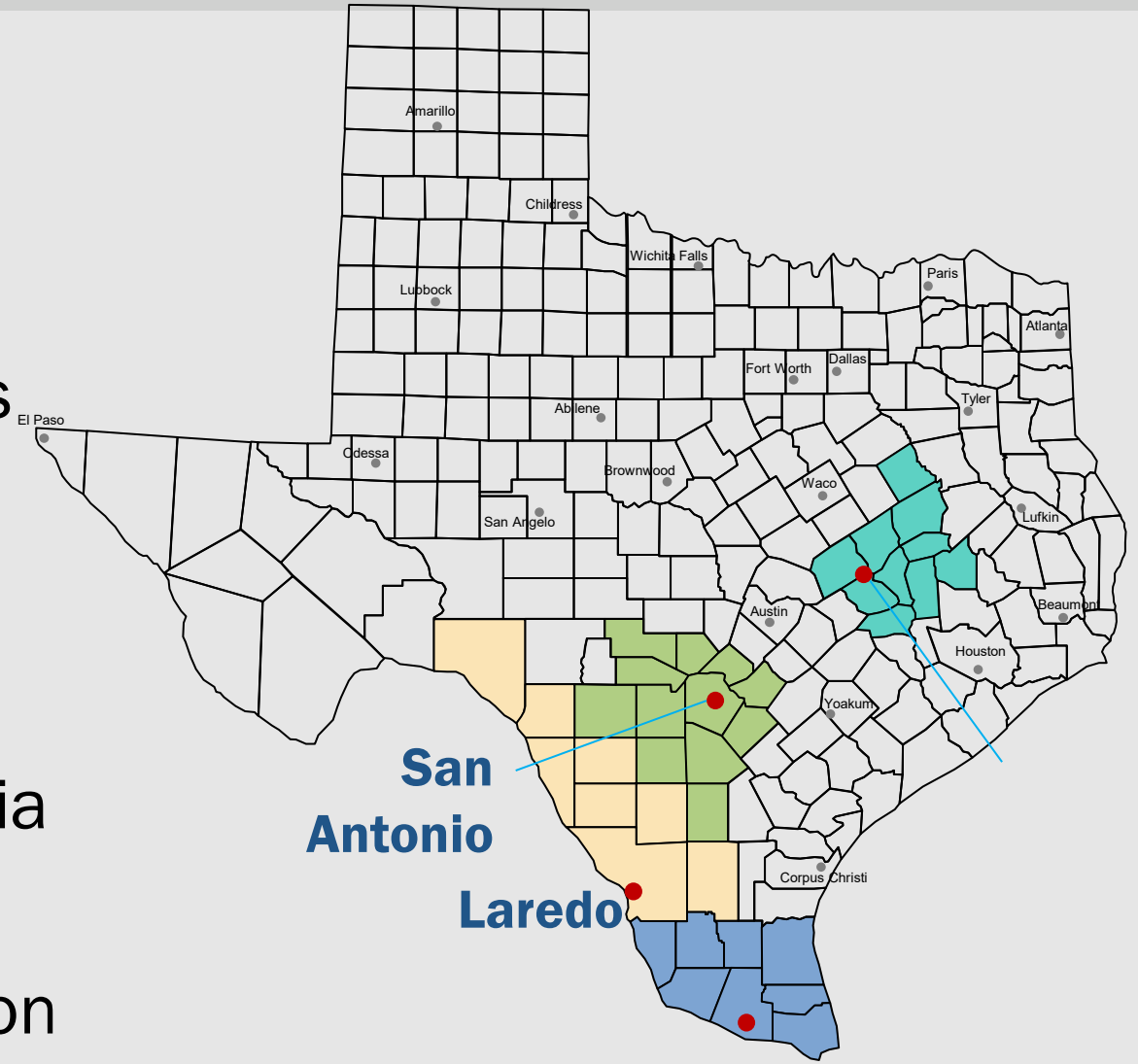


- Consultant lead: Toole Design
- Four districts participating:
 - Bryan
 - Laredo
 - Pharr
 - San Antonio
- District bike plans will analyze needs on the highway system, prioritize them, and identify potential solution types – *not* scope projects
- Currently exploring available data, developing methodology in July





- Four pilot plans → basis for future district planning and project development
- Establish methods that future districts can repeat
- Identify biking needs and deficiencies on the state highway system
- Prioritize biking needs based on criteria and weights chosen by districts
- Recommend solutions for consideration





- **District Core Team:** TxDOT staff who will manage the district plan process and coordinate with internal and external partners
- **District Technical Work Groups:** TxDOT and local/regional agency partner staff who will review draft findings and provide input on existing conditions, needs, prioritization, and implementation
- **District Equity Working Groups:** community-based organizations and stakeholders who bring an equity, environmental justice, or public health lens to the planning process

Districts determine who to invite to each group, with consultants advising.
