Election of the ATAC Co-Chair

- Every two (2) years, the ATAC will elect two (2) Co-Chairs from its current membership.
- The Co-Chairs shall be elected by a majority of the members present at the meeting.
- One Co-Chair will represent the cycling or micromobility community and one co-chair will represent the pedestrian community.
- The Co-Chairs will alternate leading ATAC meetings.

Election of the ATAC Co-Chair (contd.)

- ATAC elected Robert Hanley as the Pedestrian Co-Chair in March 2022 and elected J.D. Simpson as the Cycling or Micromobility Co-Chair in June 2022 for the 2022-2024 term.
- In December 2022, J.D. Simpson vacated her position as Co-Chair due to her change in employment.

Election of the ATAC Co-Chair (contd.)

- Nominations will be accepted from the floor for a current member to fill the remainder of the unexpired Co-Chair term, and then a motion will need to be made to accept the nominee. This Co-Chair position will represent the cycling and/or micromobility community.
- The Co-Chair will be elected by a majority of the members in attendance and the Co-Chair will serve until March 2024, when the next elections will be held.
