ATAC-TAC Position Overview

- ATAC bylaws specify that ATAC will designate two (2) representatives and (2) alternates to serve on the voting membership of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC).
 - (1) representative (Robert Hanley) and (1) alternate (*Vacant*) representing the pedestrian community.
 - (1) representative (*Vacant*) and (1) alternate (Carl Bradtmiller) representing the cycling or micromobility community.

ATAC-TAC Position Overview

- ATAC is currently seeking a *cycling or micromobility community member* to serve as the *representative* and a *pedestrian community member* to serve as the *alternate* on AAMPO's TAC.

ATAC-TAC Position Overview

- At the March 2022 ATAC meeting, committee members voted to select the ATAC Co-Chairs as representatives of ATAC on TAC.
- ATAC can accept this same proposition and select the cycling or micromobility ATAC Co-Chair*, Lauren Simcic, as the TAC representative or discuss another option.

*ATAC Bylaws do not specify Co-Chairs to be TAC representatives.

- Nominations will be accepted to fill the ATAC representative and alternate positions on TAC.
- Discussion and confirmation of nominations.
- Action to approve TAC representatives by a majority of the members in attendance.
