



**Resolution Approving the Alamo Area
Metropolitan Planning Organization's
FY 2026-2027
Unified Planning Work Program**

WHEREAS, U.S. Department of Transportation regulations require an areawide multimodal transportation plan and a continuing planning process for urbanized areas, and for the area projected to become urban within 20-25 years henceforth—the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, said mandated planning process, known as the “3C” (Continuing, Cooperative and Comprehensive) planning process, must be accomplished by a designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), and is necessary for transportation projects to qualify for federal transportation funds; and

WHEREAS, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) is the designated MPO for the San Antonio Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, AAMPO provides local direction for urban transportation planning and the allocation of federal transportation funds to entities within the region; and

WHEREAS, transportation planning to be undertaken by and under the direction of AAMPO must be contained in an approved Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP); and

WHEREAS, the AAMPO Technical Advisory Committee has recommended approval of the FY 2026-2027 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT AAMPO'S Transportation Policy Board approves the FY 2026-2027 UPWP and authorizes submittal to the Texas Department of Transportation for State and Federal approval.
